Modeling Effects

- A behavioral model shown that an important factor that promotes helping the presence of someone else who is helping.
- Tends to increase helping for several reasons:
 - a) demonstrates what kind of actions are possible or effective in the situation.
 - b) conveys the message that to offer help is appropriate in the particular situation
 - c) provides information about the costs and risks involve
