DEFINITIONS

JUVENILE PERSPECTIVE

- Antisocial – any act that violates the rules and laws of society. For eg. homicide, theft, burglary

CLINICAL/MEDICAL

- Referred as conduct disorder in DSM IV. A person under 18 demonstrates a constellation of symptoms, including aggression, deceitfulness, rule violations and property destruction

PERSPECTIVES

PERSONALITY AND SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY

- Diagnosed as Antisocial Personality Disorder (ASPD)
